

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REPORT ON 2ND EXECUTIVE STRATEGIC PLANNING MEETING OF ASIAN PACKAGING FEDERATION ON 20TH APRIL, 2017 AT SEOUL, KOREA



As per the decision taken in the 66th Board of Administration and 41th General Assembly meetings of Asian Packaging Federation held at Mumbai, India during 15-17 December, 2016, the 2nd Executive Strategic Planning meeting of Asian Packaging Federation was held at Seoul, Korea on 20th April, 2017. Prof. (Dr.) N.C.Saha has attended the meeting in the capacity of Secretary General of Asian Packaging Federation. He has conducted the meeting along with Dr. Jin Kie Shim, President, APF.

At the outset, Dr. Jin Kie Shim, President, Asian Packaging Federation (APF) welcomed to all the Office Bearers of APF and also the active Honorary Members to the 2nd Executive Strategic Planning Meeting (ESPM) at Seoul, Korea on 20th April, 2017. He had mentioned that a decision was taken by the 65th Board of Administration and General Assembly that the Office Bearers and the active honorary members



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will meet once in a year prior to the Board of Administration and General Assembly meeting to discuss about the important agendas which are normally not covered during the Board of Administration meeting due to shortage of time. Considering this, the first executive strategic planning meeting was held at Singapore on 1st April, 2016.

Similarly, the 66th BOA and 41st GA meetings of APF held at Mumbai on 16th December, 2016, it was decided to hold the 2nd Executive Strategic Planning Meeting at Seoul, Korea on 20th April, 2017. He had also thanked to all the members for their presence during the meeting to make it a grand success.

Subsequently, he requested Dr. N.C.Saha, Secretary General-APF for taking the agenda for discussion. First of all, on behalf of members of APF, Dr. N.C.Saha, SG, APF thanked to Dr.Shim for hosting this meeting at Seoul, Korea and discussed about the Agenda.

The salient points discussed during the meeting are as follows:

- Prof. (Dr.) N.C.Saha, Secretary General (SG), APF has informed to the members that as per the decision taken by the 66th BOA and 41st GA meeting that the 67th BoA and 42nd GA will be held at Singapore in the month of November, 2017 and the event will be hosted by Packaging Council of Singapore. However, APF Secretariat has received a communication dated 22nd Feb, 2017 from Ms. Betty Tan, Chairperson, Packaging Council of Singapore that due to pre-commitment, the Packaging Council of Singapore is unable to host the event in November, 2017.
- Due to this fact, the SG, APF has requested all the executive member countries to inform about their willingness to host the meeting. In response to this communication, Sri Lanka Institute of Packaging has confirmed through a communication that the Sri Lanka Institute of Packaging will host the next 67th BoA and 42nd GA at Colombo, Sri Lanka during 11-13 December, 2017.

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Accordingly, a tentative programme has also received from Sri Lanka Institute of Packaging and the same is given below:

- 11th Dec, 2017 (Monday): AsiaStar Judging and Honorary Members meeting
- 12th Dec, 2017 (Tuesday):67th BoA and 42nd GA meetings & AsiaStar Award Nite
- 13th Dec, 2017 (Wednesday): Group visit for APF delegates
- Dr. N.C.Saha, SG, APF has informed to the members that Chairman, CAPP sub-committee visited India on 20th January, 2017 and also conducted the first meeting with the faculty members of the Indian Institute of Packaging who are involved for the coordination of CAPP programme on behalf of APF. It was also finalised that the following members will be a part of CAPP Sub-Committee.
 - Mr. Dharma Ratnayake, Chairman, CAPP sub-committee (Sri Lanka)
 - Dr. N.C.Saha, Secretary General, APF (India)
 - Ms. Aslihan Arikan, 2nd Vice President, APF (Turkey)
 - Dr. Pattra Maneesin, Thai Packaging Center (Thailand)
- In addition, he has also informed to the members that APF have formally announced about the introduction of CAPP programme for three courses i.e., Plastics in Flexible Packaging, Plastics in Rigid Packaging, Paper & Paperboard packaging on 1st March, 2017.
- In this context, Dr. N.C.Saha, SG, APF has requested all the members for the circulation of this new activity of APF i.e., Certified Asian Packaging Professional (CAPP) to all the concerned industries for their participation so that large number of participants can enroll to this programme.
- Ms. Aslihan Arikan, 2nd Vice President, APF has informed that she would be visiting Vietnam to conduct a training programme on behalf of WPO and during that time, she would explore the possibility to get a connectivity with the packaging association at Vietnam. In addition, she has also mentioned that she would contact the packaging association at Kazakhstan for their participation into the next BOA and GA meeting at Sri Lanka.
- Dr. N. C. Saha, SG, APF has mentioned that he is in touch with one of the exhibition company located at Dubai and hence, it would be advisable to invite this exhibition company to the next BOA and GA meeting at Sri Lanka. He has also suggested that we may allow those companies as a Associate Member (profit organisation) USD 600 per month. In this context, the members deliberated on this point and discussed about the kind of benefits which would be availed by the exhibition company. It was discussed that we may allow these companies to take the membership by making a payment of US\$ 3000 at a time for a duration of five years. As an alternative, APF may charge an amount of US\$ 5000 which would provide the Associate Membership for 5 years and the company may also use the APF logo in their exhibitions.





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- Mr. Albert Lim has mentioned that in order to provide the benefits to the exhibition company, we
 may also take the sponsorship from this company and upload the logo in our APF website which can
 be visible at the front page and logo could be rotated.
- There will be two additional categories for ASIASTAR contest i.e., Point of Purchase (POP) and Packaging Material and Components (PMC). Hence, the Asia Star competition for the year 2017 will be held for the five different categories i.e., Commercial (CP), Transport (TP), Eco Friendly (EP), Point of Purchase (PoP) and Packaging Materials and Components (PMC) and the judging criteria will remain same for all the 5 categories. In addition, there will be Student Category (ST).
- For President Award, the two top scorers from each of 5 category will be drawn and the entries will be submitted to the President for taking a final decision. Out of 10 entries, President will have discretion to chose only one Award as President Award on his own justification.
- For the Student Category, the winners will be given only award certificates with a different design which will be different from other five categories. In addition, the folder of the certificate will also be different colour to maintain its uniqueness.
- The last date for Asia Star 2017 entries should be 30th September, 2017 and APF Secretariat will send the invoice for AsiaStar entries through online and payment will also be received through online.
- During the 66th BOA and 41st GA meetings of APF held at Mumbai, India, a discussion was held about the 50th Year celebration of Asian Packaging Federation. It was discussed that APF was established at Japan Packaging Institute, Tokyo, Japan in 1967, it would be appropriate to organize the grand finale of Golden JubileeYear (50thYear) celebration of APF at Tokyo, Japan.
- Due to this fact, the representatives from Japan Packaging Institute was also invited as a Special Invitee to the meeting to discuss about the modality for the celebration of Golden Jubilee Year of Asian Packaging Federation. Three members from Japan Packaging Institute (JPI) i.e., Mr. Shigeo Koshino, Mr. Nobuyuki Kokago along with Ms.Hiroko Akieda had attended the meeting and also participated in to the discussion.
- It was decided that the APF will publish a souvenir to highlight about the history of APF by including the office bearer for the past 50 years, photographs. In addition, the souvenir will also highlight about the important activity related to packaging has been carried out by APF during the last 50 years for the promotion of packaging technology.



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- It was decided that, on the occasion of 50th year of APF, a directory of all packaging industries hailing from Asian region will be published. In this context, it was decided that Ms. Aslihan Arikan will be the coordinator for publishing the APF directory (in CD form) and the same will be released during the Grand Finale of 50th year celebration. In line with this, APF Secretariat will request to all the member countries of APF to identify 200 leading companies from each country and the information to be sent to Ms. Aslihan for compilation. After the release of the CD of APF directory, an abstract in the form of name of the company, country and product will be uploaded to APF website. However, the detailed information in CD form can be provided by APF secretariat on payment basis.
- It was also decided that APF will prepare a short film to highlight about the objective of APF, its activities, member countries and also the comments from the leading executive member of APF. The film will be released during the Grand Finale of 50th Year.
- The members have decided that on the occasion of 50th year, the Secretariat will prepare a "Tie" with a Tie pin of 50 nos. for all the Executive members, Associate Members and Honorary Members (Gents) and 10 Scarf with APF logo (for ladies).
- It was decided that all the past presidents of APF from the different APF member countries will be invited for their participation during the grand finale of 50th year celebration where the travel cost and two night accommodation will be provided. The past presidents will be honoured with a plaque of APF.
- It was also decided that the 50th Year celebrations of APF will be celebrated throughout the year i.e., October, 2017 to October, 2018. Due to this, all the member countries are also requested to highlight about the 50th celebration of APF in the events which will be organized by the individual country during this period.
- A tentative programme was suggested by Japan Packaging Institute which is given below:

30th September, 2018 : Arrival of Guests

1st October, 2018 : Asia Star Judging & Honorary Members Meeting
 2nd October, 2018 : Opening of Tokyo Pack, BOA and GA meeting

- 3rd October, 2018 : Packaging Conference and Asia Star Award Ceremony

4th October, 2018 : Visit to the packaging industry & Group tour

It was also discussed that the APF will conduct training programme on basic packaging in the
different countries of Asian region for the benefit of small and medium entrepreneurs in the field of
packaging.
